Apprenticeships

Already employed but would like to do an Apprenticeship? The answer is yes, anyone over 16 years of age living in Wales and not in full-time education, can apply to become an Apprentice.

However, your employer must be aware of your intentions and fully committed to the additional work that is required for you to succeed.

The duration of an Apprenticeship will depend on the course taken. For instance an ILM Diploma in Management will take 2 years, whilst a Level 2 Diploma in Retail is 18 months.

Remember that an employed status Apprentice has the same employee rights as anyone else. There will be a pre-planned end date to the training programme, which would be agreed prior to enrolment. Additionally your wage and holiday entitlement would remain the same.
